Wind Dial Craft

What you will need:

- Paper
- Pencil and Pen
- String
- Scissors
- Colouring pens/crayons/pastels




Step One

Cut your paper into a circle. Then draw a spiral from the outside in.



Step Two

Inside the spiral write out each of the fruits of the spirit. These are love, joy, kindness, self-control, patience, peace, faithfulness, goodness and gentleness.



Step Three

Next, colour in your spiral. You can use whatever materials you have with you. It's a good idea to colour in both sides of the paper as when it's hanging up you'll be able to see both.



Step Four

Using your scissors, cut along the lines of your spiral so you have one long, curly line.



Step Five

Finally, make a hole with your pencil, scissors or hole punch and tie the string so that you can hang your wind dial up.
